ATTESTATION ON POWER OF ATTORNEY

For attestation related to Power of Attorney, the applicant shall appear in person for submitting his/her application. In case of Joint Power of Attorney, all the deponents shall present themselves before the consular officer of this Mission. If there is a provision for signature by witnesses in the Power of Attorney, the witnesses need to appear in person along with their ID cards/Passport.

Documents required:

Completed Miscellaneous Services Form + Power of Attorney/Document required to be attested (in duplicate) + Passport (original + photocopy) + 4 colour Photos (51 mm x 51 mm).

If the applicant does not hold Indian Passport/Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card/PIO Card, the Power of Attorney needs to be first attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Republic of Yemen.

The attestation is done within two working days excluding day of submission of application.
