Things to remember at the time of application for ICCR Scholarship

Djiboutian students may now apply for the ICCR scholarship for the academic year 2024-25. A circular has already been posted at the website of Embassy of India, Sanaa. Following are some details about how to apply for ICCR scholarship.

ICCR Application process is an online process where the applicants will access the portal through the website <http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov>. Before beginning the process, candidate may ensure that all the education documents listed below are translated and attested by local Ministry of foreign Affairs. Candidate may keep the digital scanned copies ready to upload on the portal. The portal is opening on 4th April 2024.

- **Eligibility Criteria:** For admission in Undergraduate level courses, it is compulsory to have 10+2 i.e; (12 years) of schooling. It is, therefore, necessary that the student applying for UG level courses must complete 12 years of schooling.
- **List of Documents required to upload on A2A portal:**
 - * Certified copies of mark sheets (Transcripts),
 - * Diploma certificate etc.
 - * Certified translation of the education documents in English.
 - * Copy of passport (with validity of more than 6 months).
 - * Test scores of English standardized tests like TOEFL/IELTS may be sought by the concerned Universities.
 - * For MBA admission, GMAT test score.
 - * Passport size photo.
 - * Two recommendation letters.
 - * Birth certificate OR National ID.
 - * Filled up medical fitness form (Form can be downloaded from the portal)
 - * Any other scholastic documents if available.
- **How to access A2A portal:** Application process is completely online process. The portal may be accessed at the <http://a2ascholarships.iccr.gov>. The candidate will register and generate a user name and password. Once registered, the candidate may follow the instruction provided on the portal to upload the documents. Please note, no fields should be left empty in order to submit the application successfully.
- **Students are required to obtain the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) equivalence (if needed).** This would be stipulated by the concerned University/ Institute in their Provisional Confirmation letter for the applicant (uploaded on Portal). In case AIU equivalence is required the student may apply for the same at the link <https://evaluation.aiu.ac.in/student/login> and bear the fees incurred on obtaining the certificate at their own expense (non-reimbursable). - Interested students are advised to visit respective University / institute website regularly for courses offered, eligibility criteria and general information about the University / institute before applying for admission. The students should ensure that they are eligible for the course and meet the eligibility criteria and should submit relevant documentation as required by the Universities, in addition to the basic certificates mentioned in the application form. They are also advised to refer to the University's Handbook/University Grants Commission's website etc. Based on the choice of University, the student may familiarize him/herself with the living conditions/weather conditions of the place in which the University is located.
- The admissions in Medical/ Paramedical (Nursing / Physiotherapy / anaesthesia etc.) / fashion / law courses / integrated courses such as BALLB (5 Years) / BSC & MSC (5 Years) etc. are **not admissible** under the scheme.
