2. 07 students have been admitted at Andhra University, Vishakhapatnam. The Andhra University have requested the students to report for physical classes beginning from 25th January 2021 and 05 students who approached the Mission have been granted Student Visas. The classes at Punjabi University, Patiala, are also starting with examination on 26th January 2021 and Mr. Mohamed Moussa Mohamed has been admitted there has also been granted visa.

- 3. The air tickets for 05 students going to Andhra University are being booked on the sector Djibouti-Vishakhapatnam and for Punjabi University for Djibouti-Chandigarh and will be handed over to them shortly. However, the physical classes for the other ICCR scholars have not started yet and action would be taken for their visas and air tickets once the Mission gets further information about their joining the respective universities.
- 4. A briefing session was organized for all Djibouti scholars to acquaint them with the ICCR scholarship guidelines; their universities and the local conditions in India. They have also been advised to keep adequate amount of funds for incidental expenditure on their arrival in India.
